THE RULES

- Chemicals must not be leaking – parafilm and double bag leaking containers as necessary
- Chemicals must be packaged so they won't break: use a sturdy box, use packing materials if necessary
- Liquid and solid chemicals must be packaged in separate boxes
- Chemicals must be packed by compatibility (i.e. do not package acids with bases or flammables with oxidizers)
- Highly hazardous chemicals should be segregated and well labeled on the outer package
- Package pesticides separately
