


# WHMIS 2015 Workplace Label Requirements

**a** **PRODUCT IDENTIFIER**  
Methanol

**b** **WHMIS HAZARD PICTOGRAM(S)**



**c** **SAFE HANDLING PRECAUTIONS**  
**DANGER** ~~or WARNING~~

Highly flammable liquid and vapour  
Toxic if swallowed  
Toxic if contact with skin  
Toxic if inhaled  
Causes damage to organ

**a** **PRODUCT IDENTIFIER**  
Enter the product name exactly as it appears on the Safety Data Sheet (SDS).

**b** **HAZARD PICTOGRAMS**  
Select (by checking the box) which **hazard pictograms are relevant to the product**. See SDS for product hazard information and for which pictograms are required. Block out all non-applicable pictograms.

**c** **SAFE HANDLING PRECAUTIONS**  
Enter the standardized statements given in the product's SDS:

- A **signal word (DANGER or WARNING)** is required.
- **Hazard statements** are required. See SDS for applicable hazard statements.
- **Precautionary Statements**
- All necessary information for the safe handling of the product including:
  - Personal protective equipment (PPE) required;
  - Emergency measures; and
  - First aid measures

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- WHMIS 1988 labels must be replaced with a WHMIS 2015 supplier or workplace label.
  - Labels must meet the workplace language requirements for WHMIS 2015.
  - Labels must be easy to read and durable.
  - If the label is lost, damaged, or no longer readable, the product must be relabeled.
