



## Safety Requirements Checklist for Contractors

### Purpose and Procedure:

This checklist is intended be used as a supporting document of the Contractor Code of Practice (CCOP). The Health and Safety Checklist for Contractors defines the safety requirements for contractors to work at the University of Saskatchewan.

Contractors and Service Providers wishing to work at the University of Saskatchewan must:

- A. Meet the mandatory requirement of Saskatchewan Construction Safety Association (SCSA) Certificate of Recognition (COR) or the Small Employer Certificate of Recognition (SECOR), or equivalent, Contractors and Service Providers must submit the Certificate of Recognition or Small Employer Certificate of Recognition with their bid documents,
- B. Adhere to the Contractor Code of Practice (CCOP), and
- C. Provide the following with their bid documents:
